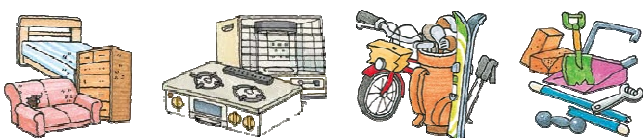

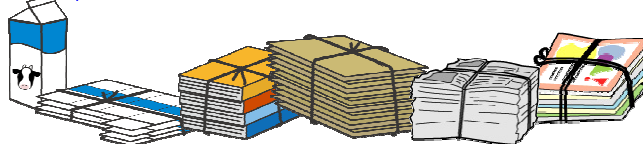

Arrange pick-up date and attach large-sized waste sticker



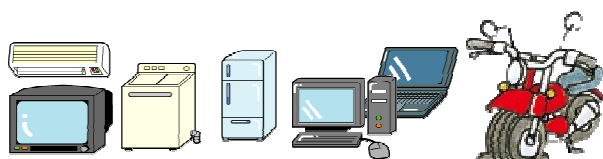

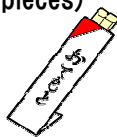
## Burnable Waste

(Collected at waste collection points (twice a week))  
(Use designated waste bag or garbage processing ticket)

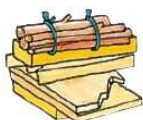

## Non-Burnable Waste

(Collected at waste collection points (twice a month))  
(Use designated waste bag or garbage processing ticket)

### Wood (thick pieces, bundles)



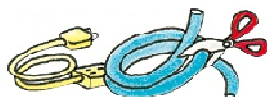
### Glass, ceramic, metal products



### Plastic products thick or large

### Small furniture, rugs, futons

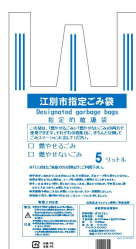


## Designated Garbage Bags and Garbage Processing Tickets

### < Designated Garbage Bags >

- Designated Garbage bags are used for Burnable and Non-burnable Waste.
  - The bags are available for purchase from 1 bag at local supermarkets and convenience stores.
1. Tie the bag to prevent the contents from spilling.
  2. When the bag is ripped, repair it with tape.
  3. If you prefer the contents of the bag not to be seen, place them in other bags first.

Size	Price per bag
5-liter bag	15 yen
10-liter bag	30 yen
20-liter bag	60 yen
30-liter bag	90 yen
40-liter bag	120 yen



### < Garbage Processing Tickets >

- Attach garbage processing tickets for waste which does not fit in the specified waste bags, and is one meter in length or less.
  - Tickets are available for purchase from 1 ticket at local supermarkets and convenience stores.
1. Attach garbage processing ticket directly on waste where it can clearly be seen.
  2. Do not place waste in or tickets on a cardboard box or a clothing case.
  3. To prevent reuse, tickets are perforated. Once a ticket is ripped, it can not be used again.



Size of waste	Price
Length or diameter of 50 cm or less	100 yen ticket per item
Twigs and wooden materials with length of 1m or less and diameter of 10 cm or less	100 yen ticket per item
Length or diameter of 50 cm to 1m (except twigs)	200 yen ticket per item

Put out waste by 8:45 am of collection day.

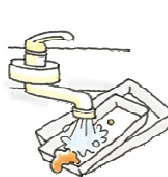

## Hazardous Waste

(Collected at waste collection points (twice a month))  
(Free)

■ Spray cans, gas cartridges

※ Do not make a hole in the can.



■ Fluorescent light bulbs

※Place in paper box to prevent breaking.



■ Dry-cell and button batteries, mercury thermometers, gas and oil lighters



※Divide items by category and use transparent or semitransparent bags.

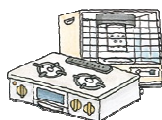

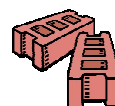

1. Call large-sized waste collection reception at 011-380-6000 (Japanese Only)
2. Purchase a large-sized waste ticket. (The price depends on the type of waste. Please ask the receptionist. It is either 250 yen, 500 yen, or 1000 yen.)
3. After scheduling a pickup appointment, attach the designated ticket to the item and put it out at the specified date, time, and location for collection.

●When using designated red garbage bags or garbage disposal tickets from October 2024.

Due to the change to blue designated garbage bags, etc., please put a "difference ticket" on red designated garbage bags and a "20 yen ticket" on garbage disposal tickets depending on the type of bag.

## Paper (Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, etc. ) (Free)

Newspapers, magazines, and cardboard are collected by neighborhood organizations for free.

✂Paper is handled as burnable waste by the City.



## Winter trash disposal precautions.

(Garbage disposal during the neighborhood association snow removal work)

If garbage collection and snow removal work by the neighborhood association overlap, garbage collection will not be possible. Therefore, please refrain from putting out your garbage and put it out on the next collection day according to your garbage category. In addition, if the garbage collection day coincides with the snow removal day of the neighborhood association, the person in charge of the neighborhood association must contact the city office in advance and discuss the areas that cannot be collected.
